How to use the WebGauge®?

1. Print this page and check whether the ruler on the left ① is 12 cm long. If it is not, you will have to adjust your print settings.
2. Cut out the WebGauge® ② as indicated.
3. Wrap the WebGauge® around your finger, keeping the measurements on the outside and sliding the wide end (A) underneath the straight end. Draw it tight enough so that there is no more space between your finger and the gauge.

The measurement  corresponding to the wide end (A) indicates the circumference of your finger (B), expressed as your ring size. The average ring size of women is 6½; of men, 10.

4. Choose the right reference of item when ordering your ring. Or, if the case arises, don't forget to specify your ring size on the paper order form.
